From Columbus: Follow I-70 West past Springfield to I-675 South (Exit 44). Follow I-675 South for approximately 15 minutes to Exit 17-N. Fairfield Rd. Turn right onto N. Fairfield Rd. At second stoplight, turn left onto Col. Glenn Highway. At first stoplight, turn left onto Center Park Blvd. Go through the intersection at Presidential Dr. and turn left into the parking lot.

From Cincinnati: Follow I-75 North past Middletown. Take the I-675 North exit (exit 43). Follow I-675 for approximately 15 minutes to Exit 17-N. Fairfield Rd. The exit ramp will split; stay to the right. Turn left onto N. Fairfield Rd. At third stoplight, turn left onto Col. Glenn Highway. At first stoplight, turn left onto Center Park Blvd. Go through the intersection at Presidential Dr. and turn left into the parking lot.

From Toledo: Take I-75 South to I-70 East to I-675 South. Follow I-675 South for approximately 15 minutes to Exit 17-N. Fairfield Rd. At second stoplight, turn left onto Col. Glenn Highway. At first stoplight, turn left onto Center Park Blvd. Go through the intersection at Presidential Dr. and turn left into the parking lot.

From Cleveland: Take I-71 South toward Columbus to I-270 West. Merge onto I-70 West. Follow to I-675 South. Stay on I-675 for approximately 15 minutes to Exit 17-N. Fairfield Rd. Turn right onto N. Fairfield Rd. At second stoplight, turn left onto Col. Glenn Highway. At first stoplight, turn left onto Center Park Blvd. Go through the intersection at Presidential Dr. and turn left into the parking lot.
